Important Announcement from owners of Sew Let's Quilt It:



Sew Let's Quilt It is <u>NOT</u> Closing at this time.
The store is <u>OPEN</u> and will be operating as usual through September!

Our Block of the Month Program

This year we are making patriotic star blocks to make 9-block quilt tops for our Veterans program. Instructions for each block will appear monthly in the newsletter and instructions for all 9 blocks are on our website.

Block tally as of June meeting: Jan - 14; Feb - 13; March - 12; April - 10; May - 9; June -11



Fabric needed: white background, dark blue, light blue, and red. From white, red, and light blue: cut two 5.5" squares from each.

From dark blue: cut four 3 1/2" squares.



Sew down each side of the square set using an accurate 1/4" seam allowance.

Cut the sewn square diagonally both ways to make four half-square triangles.

Press the HST with the darker color fabric on top. Trim the dog ears to eliminate bulk.

Hint: if you wish, you can make the 5.5" square a little bigger and trim the HST to 3 ½".

Sew the square together as shown.

If you haven't started yet, there is still time to catch up and complete the 9 blocks by October.

Many heartfelt thanks to everyone who has submitted blocks so far.

Lonetta's husband Jim has gotten his sight back and can read now. Prayers were answered.


Shadows
